*The work with resin invites us to explore beauty through transparency, organic form, and the tension between the natural and the structured.*

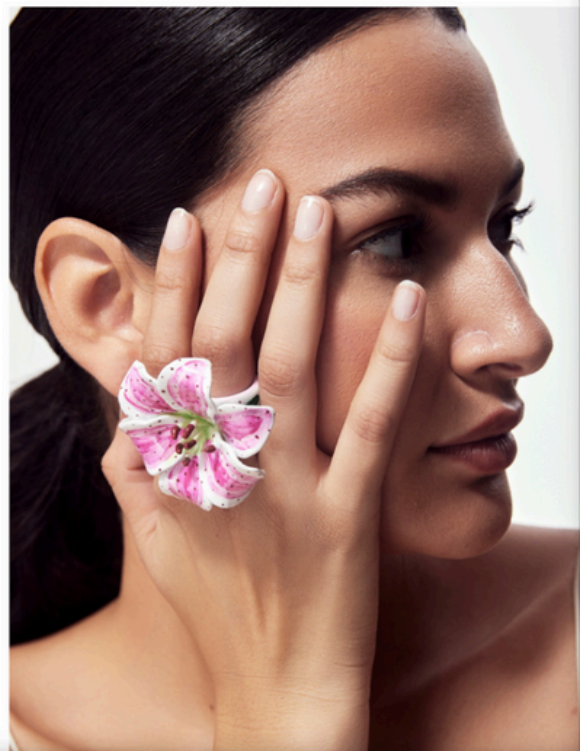
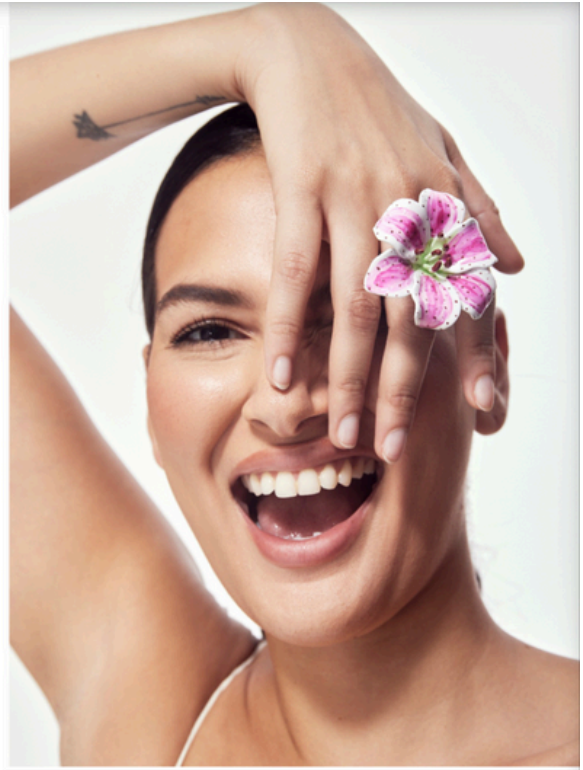




# ROSELILY RING

Tags are attached with water-soluble threads that dissolve in natural water sources, protecting wildlife and ecosystems.



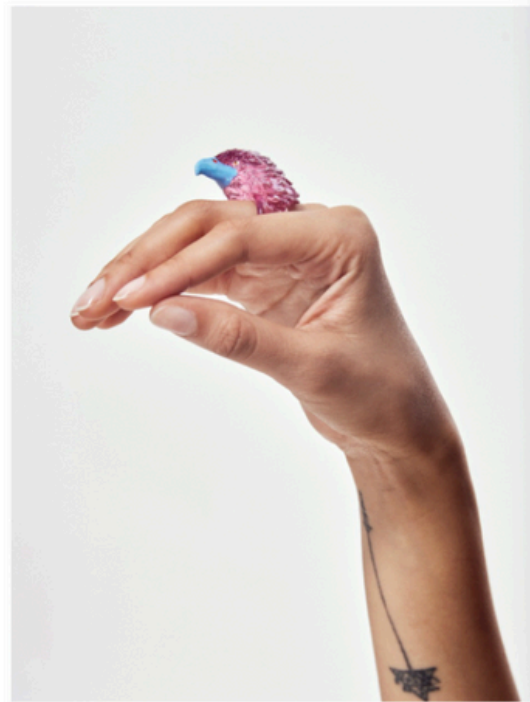


We use plant-based and bio-resins that are better for the planet. Our raw materials are made in the USA, reducing transport emissions and supporting local industry.
